The Open Design Studio at Duke is looking for a project manager to help plan and execute a virtual professional learning program for K-12 educators called the Open Design Academy. The Open Design Academy, a collaboration between the Open Design Studio and the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction, will train educators in open design, an equity-centered innovation process.

We are looking for a graduate or advanced undergraduate student to help with **overall project management** including: **logistics and administrative support** (recruitment and registration of educators, setting up Slack communication channels, organizing online resources and learning modules); **program evaluation** (administer and analyze survey results); **website design** (create a simple WordPress site to house learning modules and learning resources); **communications** (maintain clear and transparent communication channels between Open Design Academy leads and participants via Slack).
